2. Admission Criteria :-

Science Stream	80% in Maths, Science, English and 80% Aggregate in Eng, Maths, Science, Social Science, Hindi/Sanskrit.
Commerce Stream	70% in Maths, English, Social Science and 70% Aggregate in Eng, Maths, Science, Social Science, Hindi/Sanskrit.

- The duly filled in registration form, should be submitted on or before 22.02.2018.
- Documents to be submitted:-
 - Duly filled in Registration form.
 - 2 copies of the photographs of the child (in school uniform), mother, father and local guardian (if applicable) each. (Same as pasted on the registration form).
 - Attach Xerox copy of certificate(s) of participation in co-curricular activities at Zonal/National/International Level.
- Admission will be granted on meeting the eligibility criteria.
- Special scholarships/Admission fee waiver** will be provided to exceptionally meritorious and deserving students.
- Special preference/consideration** will be given to students who have qualified **NTSE and other Olympiads**.
