

Inter- house Cryptic Crossword and Sudoku Competitions

“If you are curious, you'll find the puzzles around you. If you are determined, you will solve them.”

With an aim to enhance the critical thinking and decision making power of the students, an inter-house Cryptic Crossword and Sudoku Competitions were organised at SBPS. Both the competitions took place in two categories, Junior category (grade VI to VIII) and Senior category (grade IX to XII). In the cryptic crossword, there were two members in each team who were provided with a time duration of 30 minutes to solve the crosswords. In the Junior category (grade VI to VIII), Yajurveda house was declared as the winner followed by Rigveda house in the second position and Samveda house in the third. In the Senior category (grade IX to XII), Rigveda house bagged the first position. Atharvaveda and Samveda bagged the second and third position respectively.

In the Sudoku competition, each team was represented by one participant and all of them worked hard to complete the puzzles in the shortest time possible within the time frame of 45 minutes. Samveda house emerged victorious in the both the categories of the competition. In the junior category (grade VI to VIII), Atharvaveda house secured the second position and Yajurveda, the third. In the senior category (grade IX to XII), Yajurveda grabbed the second position and Atharvaveda, the third. The students of all the four houses were at their best in both the competitions.

School Head Personnel & Admin Mr. Pradip Varma congratulated the winners and encouraged others to participate in such competitions.
