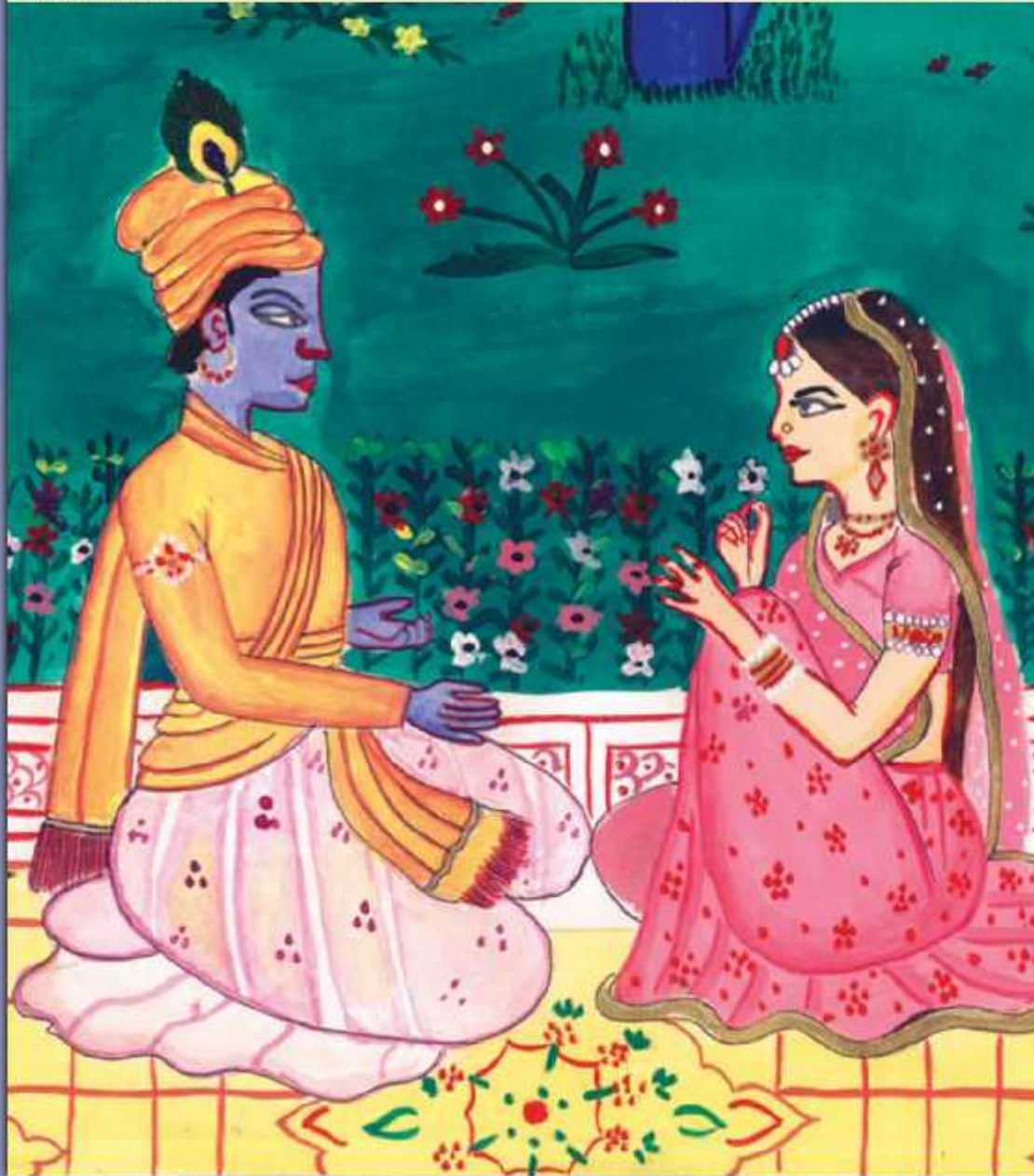

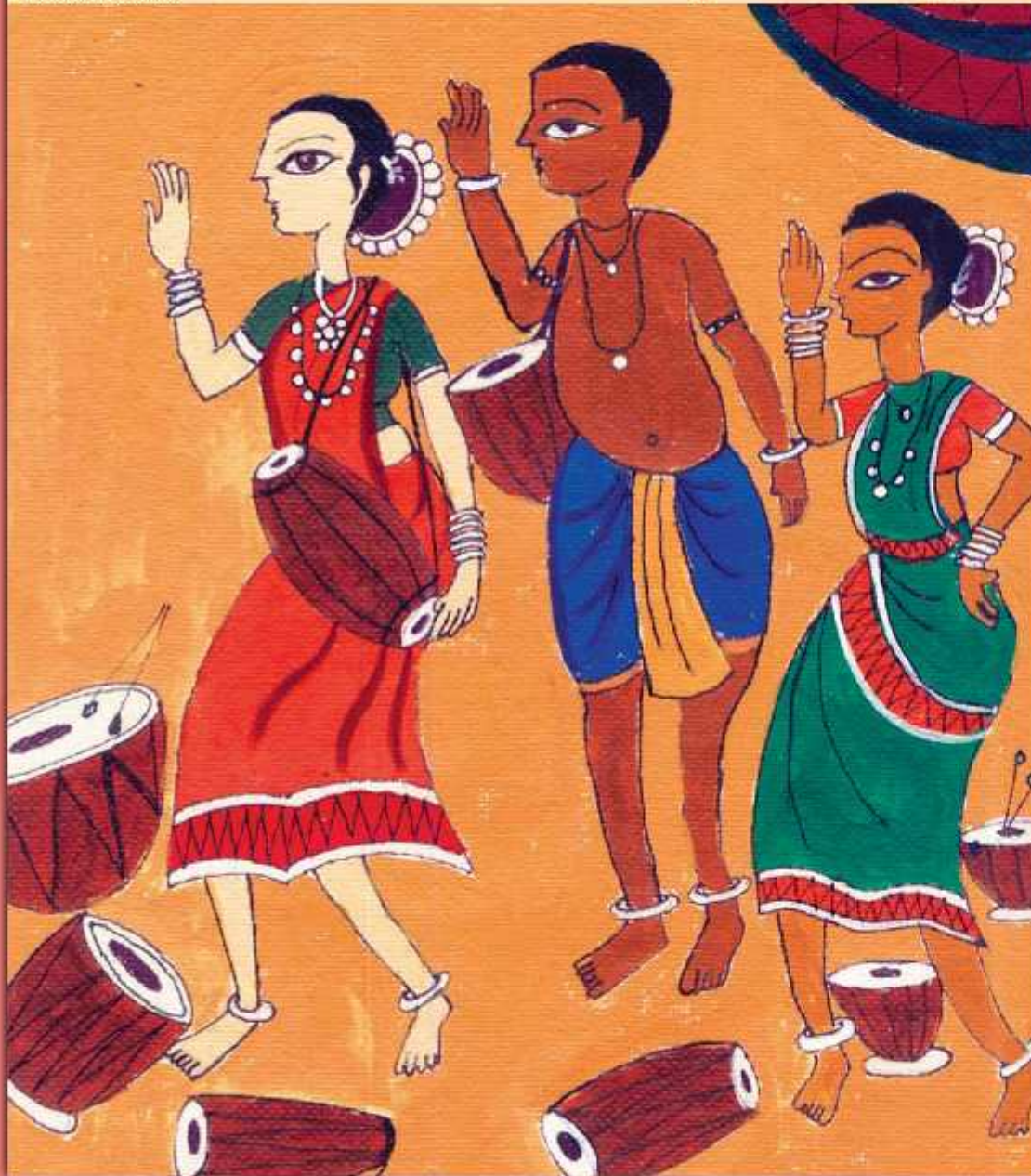
Bengal Pattachitra refers to the painting of West Bengal. The subject matter of Bengal Pattachitra is mostly mythological, religious, stories, and folklore.

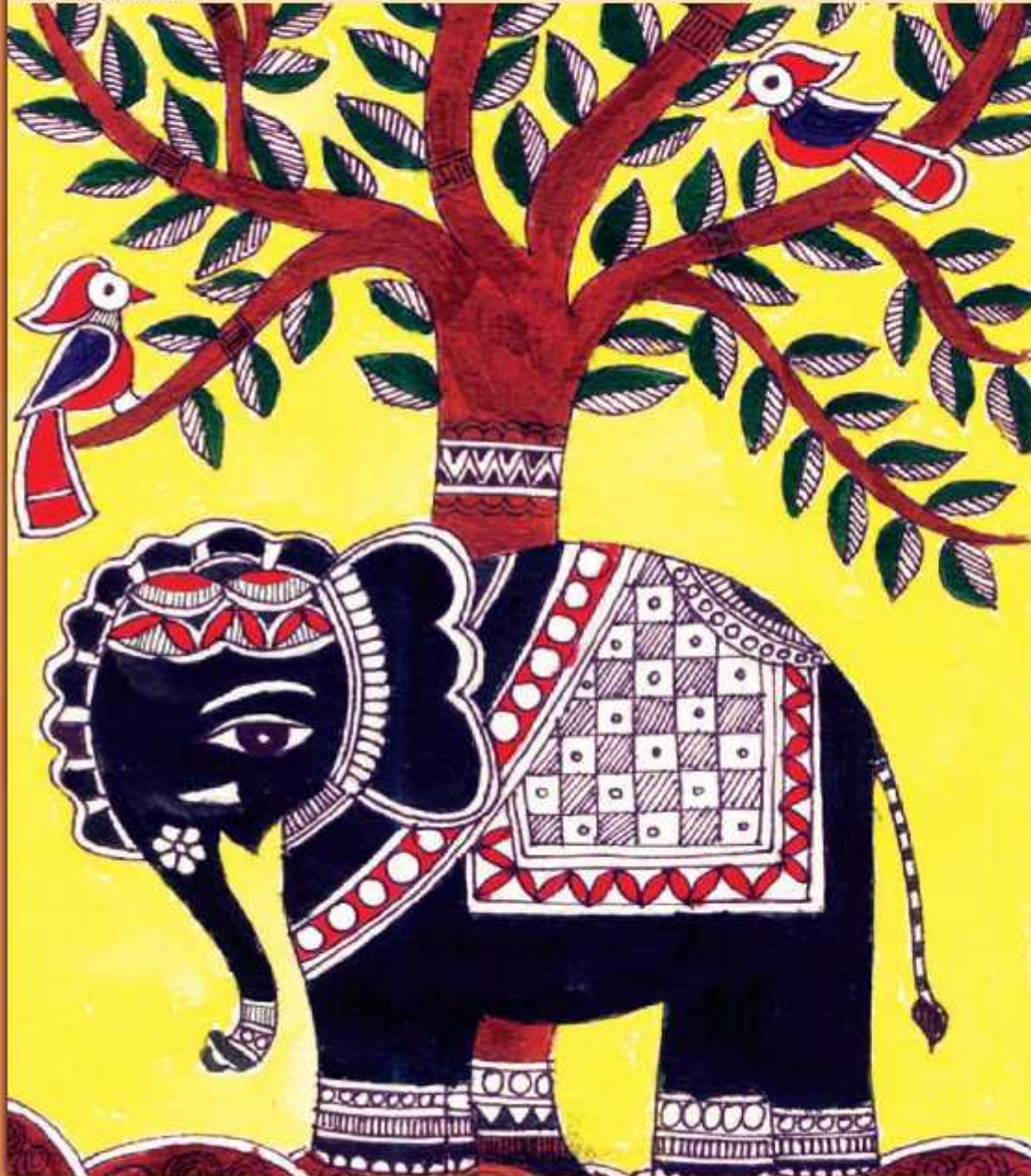

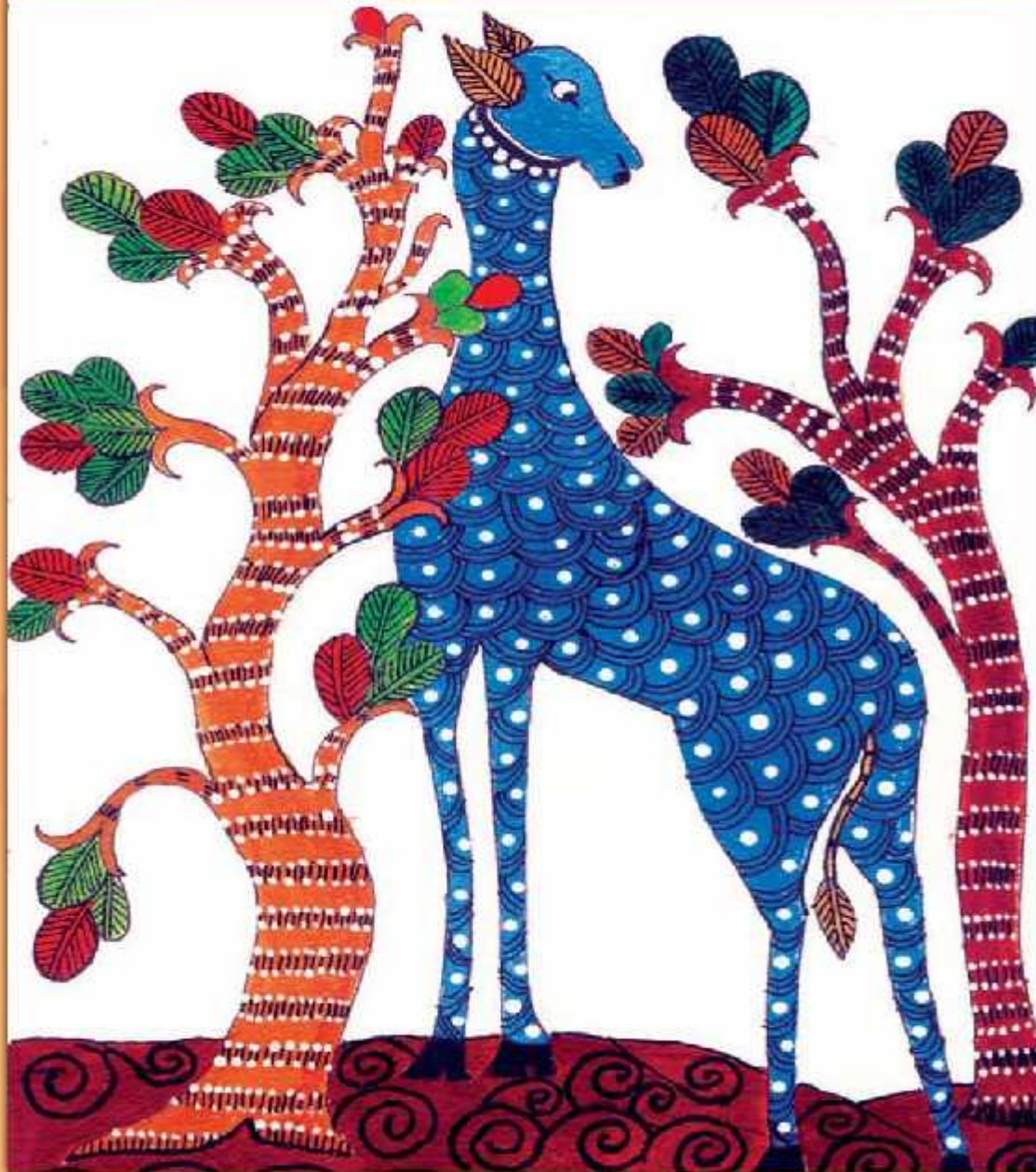

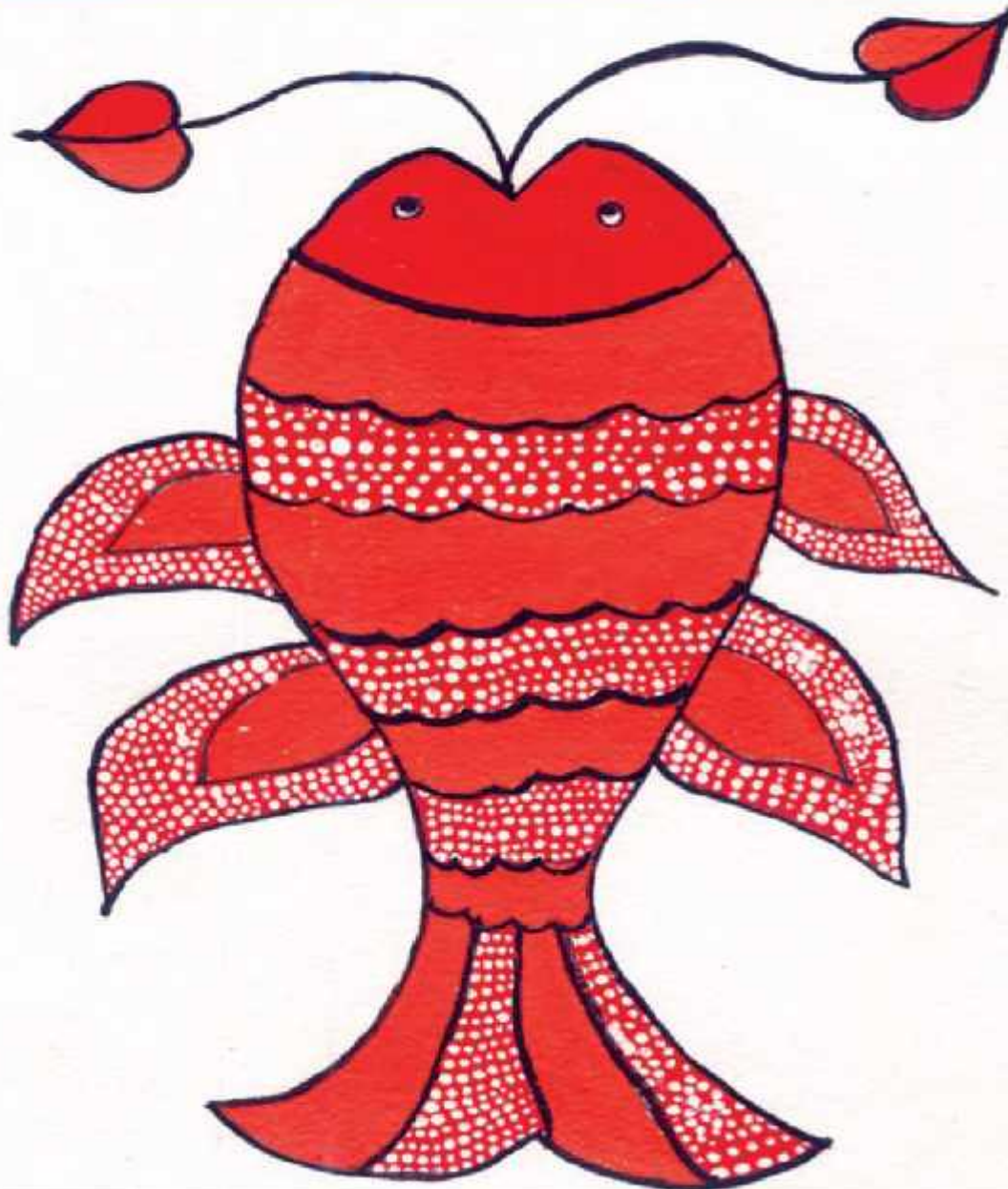
