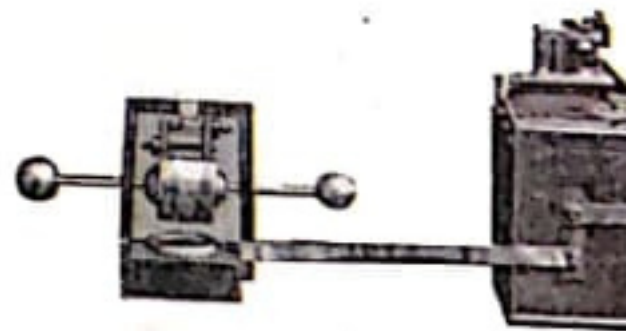

Origin- from Middle French; Late Latin ; late 16th century

Synonyms- jolly, happy, amiable
