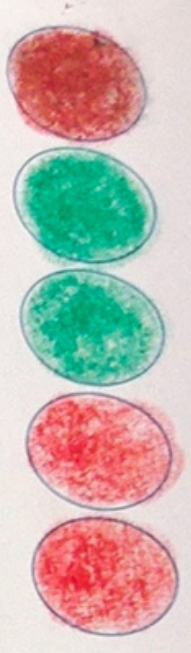

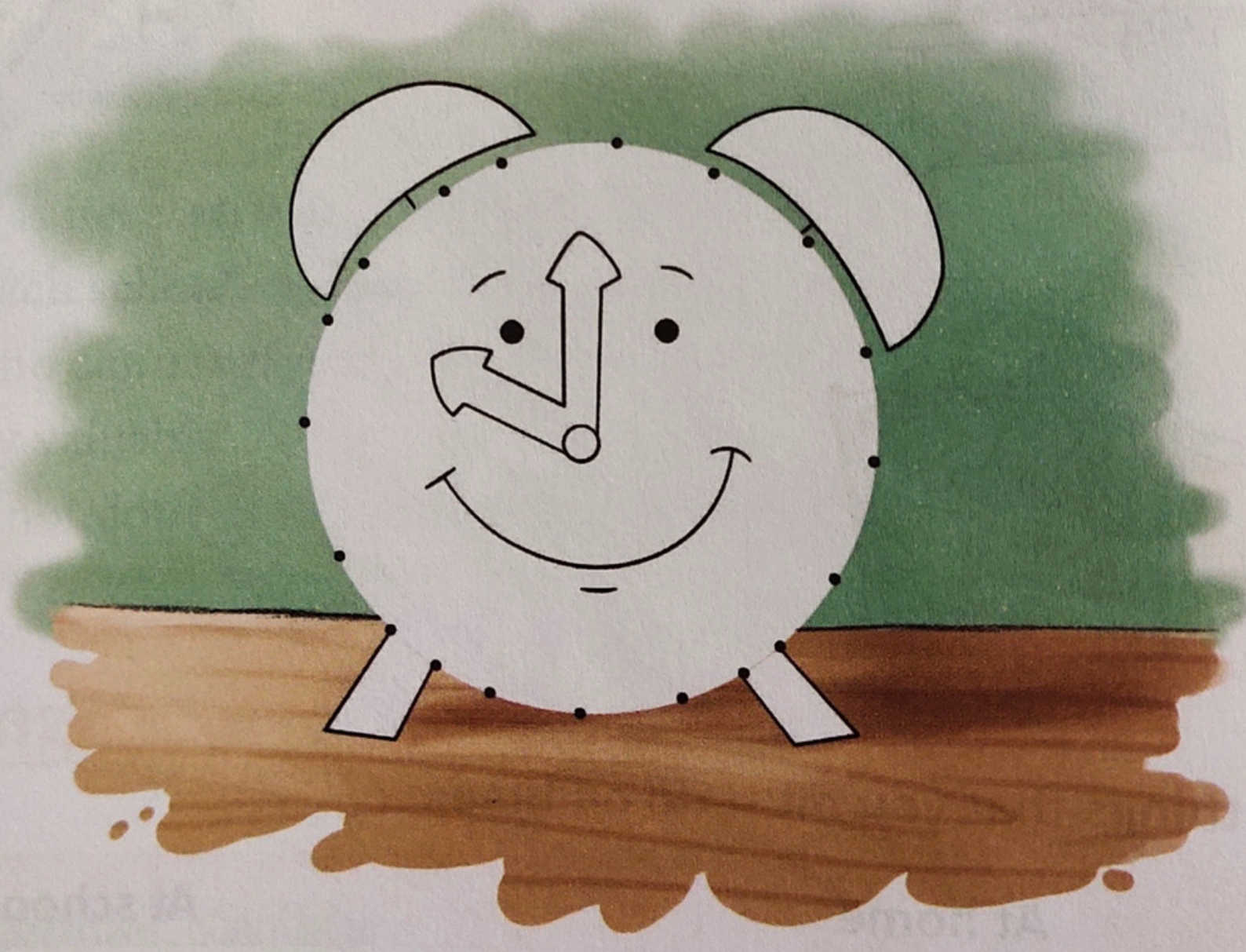

Ans3. Hard work is the most important thing for success.

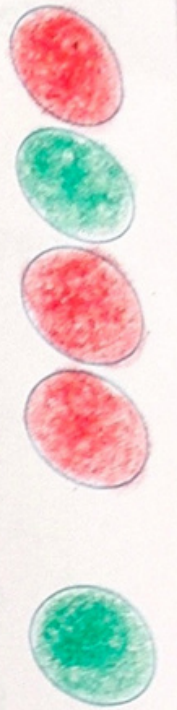
