#### **GRAMMAR STD V-CH 1 NOUNS**

#### **EXPLANATION**

**Nouns**- A noun is a naming word. It refers to a person, place, animal or thing. Eg: Tom, Ranchi, girl, dog, pen, etc.

It can be further classified into various types:

- 1. **Common Noun** A general name given for a group of person, place, animal or thing. A Common noun is not written in capital letter. Eg: girls, city, etc.
- 2. **Proper Noun** A noun that is used to identify an individual person, place, animal or thing. It is always written in capital letter. Eg: Ravi, London etc.
- 3. **Singular Noun** A noun that identifies one person, place, thing or idea is known as a Singular Noun. Eg: boy, car, city, etc
- 4. **Plural Noun** A noun that names more than a person, place, thing or an idea is known as a Plural Noun. Most of the singular nouns becomes plural when an 's' is added to it. Eg: boys, cars, cities etc.

Plural Nouns can further be classified in two categories:

- a) Regular Plurals
- b) Irregular Plurals
- a) Regular Plurals- Nouns that form Plurals by adding -s or -es are called regular plurals.

Eg: girl-girls

- **b)** Irregular Plurals-Some nouns form plurals by changing their spellings. Such nouns are called irregular plurals.
  - **Rule: 1**. Nouns ending with -y is changed to plural by adding -ies to it and removing y like: baby-babies
  - **Rule :2** Nouns ending with -f,-fe (except dwarf-dwarfs) changes to plural by removing –f and adding -ves like: calf-calves

Rule: 3 Some nouns change vowels in plural form like: man-men

Rule: 4 Some nouns completely changes their forms in plural like: ox- oxen

Rule: 5 Some nouns remain the same in singular as well as plural like: deer-deer

**Rule: 6** Some nouns are always used in the plural like: scissors, trousers and spectacles.

**Rule: 7** Some nouns have only singular forms like: news, furniture and scenery.
