Circumstances leading to Civil Disobedience Movement(1922 to 1929)

1. Growing demand within the Congress for return to Council politics; formation of Swaraj Party; support for radical mass struggles among the younger Congress leaders.
2. Worldwide economic depression—demand of agricultural products declined, exports came down, agricultural prices fell.
3. Simon Commission- it was formed to look into the functioning of the constitutional system in India & to suggest further changes; boycotted by all parties as it had no Indian member.
4. Lord Irwin’s offer—dominion status in an unspecified future, & Round Table Conference to discuss a future constitution.
5. Lahore session of Congress- adoption of the demand for “Purna Swaraj” & to celebrate 26th Jan. 1930 as independence day
