Pupils excelled in 9th Ranchi District Karate Championship, 2017. It is a matter of pride that 3 children namely Arnav Sinha of Grade II, Shreyansh Raj of Grade II and Akarsit Anand of Grade III participated in this championship and in sparring(Kumite) and solo demonstration of moves and steps(kata). Arnav Sinha won two gold and one silver, Shreyansh Raj bagged one gold and one silver and Akarsit Anand got two bronze medals. It was their hard work and consistent effort that enabled the children to bag the laurels.
